As one of three original partners at Thriva LLC, I was charged with developing a comprehensive online registration and management system. We grew the company from our original three people to over 60 employees over the span of seven years. We provided services for very high profile clients such as; Boeing, Stanford University, UCLA, NATO, the United Nations, JPMorgan Chase, NORAD, and over 1,200 other clients. The system and services we provided at Thriva became an industry standard and we clearly became the dominant provider within our market. Thriva was acquired by the Active Network in 1997 and continues to provide quality registration solutions to thousands of clients.

As lead project manager at MAJIQ for the largest account held by the company, I managed the production management system for nine paper mills. Also, I aided in the support of over 50 other mills as a PMiS expert. I moved into this position after only one year with the company. The systems I maintained contained extremely complex business rules and comprised of over 4,000 modules each. I had up to three people under me at one time.
